CONFESSION

Confession

“As a community, our corporate confession of sin is a three-fold acknowledgment that (1) the world is not the way it was meant to be, (2) we as a church are not the way we were meant to be, and (3) I am not the way I was meant to be. Sin’s invasion into our world and our hearts has corrupted all of us, and apart from the mercy of God, we are without hope.”

The passage below is part of our sermon text, and it’s the account of Joseph’s brothers confessing their sins to him and his response. Notice that they acknowledge their sin for what it is, evil. Pay attention to their physical posture afterwards. How does Joseph respond? As you consider his response, consider also God’s response to our own confessions.

Genesis 50:15-21 [ESV]

When Joseph's brothers saw that their father was dead, they said, “It may be that Joseph will hate us and pay us back for all the evil that we did to him.” So they sent a message to Joseph, saying, “Your father gave this command before he died: ‘Say to Joseph, “Please forgive the transgression of your brothers and their sin, because they did evil to you.”’ And now, please forgive the transgression of the servants of the God of your father.” Joseph wept when they spoke to him. His brothers also came and fell down before him and said, “Behold, we are your servants.” But Joseph said to them, “Do not fear, for am I in the place of God? As for you, you meant evil against me, but God meant it for good, to bring it about that many people should be kept alive, as they are today. So do not fear; I will provide for you and your little ones.” Thus he comforted them and spoke kindly to them.






